

SENEGAL FATICK LEARNING VISIT

FEBRUARY 9-15, 2025

On this trip we will be visiting the Senegal Fatick program, which began in 2024 and is implemented by World Renew and local partner Église Luthérienne du Sénégal (Lutheran Church of Senegal).

This program primarily works with people in the Serere ethnic group, the smallest and most conservative of the three major ethnicities in the country. Women in the Serere ethnic group typically work in their husband's fields to contribute to the family's nutrition, but unlike many of their neighboring ethnic groups, Serere women do not own any of these crops. This program is serving these vulnerable women by helping them to form women's associations.

The program combines food security and nutrition programming to improve the well-being of farmer households in 20 villages in the Fatick and Tambacounda regions of Senegal. Through training and coaching on nutrition, establishing Community Agriculture Forums, and training and coaching on sustainable dry and rainy season agriculture, the program aims to improve the food security and health of 750 households in 20 villages.
